A guest friendly morning including thanksgiving and prayer for Edith, Victoria and their families. The service will be slightly shorter and followed by coffee and cake.

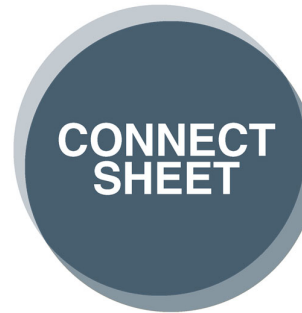

Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message. If you're in a Core Connect Group, it would be helpful to read them before you meet and note down your thoughts.



**The Spirit is Jesus with Us
John 14:12-31**

- 1) What was the most helpful part of the Bible message on Sunday?
- 2) What do you think of the idea that through the Spirit, Jesus comes to us, is with us and is in us?
- 3) Do you feel that you have the Spirit in you or ever feel that you don't? Why? What is actually the case, according to the promise of Jesus?



4) What experiences have you had of the Spirit helping you, teaching or reminding you of God's word, or giving you peace?

5) How important is it to say this was the work of the Spirit, or can we say it was Jesus or God the Father? What do you think?

6) What steps could you take to be more aware of, more dependent on and benefit more from Jesus' presence with you through the Holy Spirit?

PRAY

- Thank God for sending the Spirit to be with us and in us.
- Pray for a greater awareness and dependence on Jesus through the Spirit as you go about the normal events of life.
- Pray about particular things you would like God to help you with, or teach you or give you peace about through the Spirit.

Going Further

Read John 7:37-39

- 1) What does Jesus say which confirms again that all Christians receive the Holy Spirit?
- 2) How might the Spirit in us be like rivers of living water?
- 3) What thirsts are quenched by us having the Spirit in us?
- 4) How might all of this relate to us as witnesses for Jesus?
- 5) How could the Spirit in you begin to have a positive influence and overflow to non-Christians around you?
