An action packed weekend at Stoneleigh showground in Coventry.



Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message. If you're in a Core Connect Group, it would be helpful to read them before you meet and note down your thoughts.

Shine the Light (Matthew 5:13-16)

- 1) Do you find it easier to speak about the love of Jesus or to demonstrate the love of Jesus to people who don't know him?

- 2) Can you think of any examples of Christians being salt and light in practical ways, that have changed lives in large or small ways?

- 3) What are some of the ways that we as Christians can lose our saltiness or hide our light?



4) How have you ever heard of it working, or how could you imagine it working, for a person to become a Christian through seeing a Christian's good works?

5) How can we help one another and shine out together the light of Jesus in practical ways as a church?

6) Who could go on your BLESS list and what are your next steps to bless them?

PRAY

- Thank God for shining the light of Jesus into your life and the very practical, costly love and sacrifice of Jesus to save us.
- Pray for God the Holy Spirit's help to live out your faith in Jesus in a visible way and for change and progress where you need it.
- Pray about who God wants to bless through you, what to do next, and that someone you know would come to glorify God as a Christian.

Going Further

Read 1 Peter 2:11-17

- 1) How do you think the Christians, that Peter was writing to, were being treated?
- 2) What are some of the ways that Peter encourages them to live good lives and do good deeds?
- 3) How does Peter say that God will use this; what effect will it have?
- 4) How could you encourage a Christian, using these verses, who is suffering for their faith?
