Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message. If you're in a Core Connect Group, it would be helpful to read them before you meet and note down your thoughts.

Avoiding awkwardness Romans 1:16,17

- 1) What do you find embarrassing or awkward about talking about Jesus?

- 2) What can you do about those things?

- 3) If you had just one minute to tell someone the gospel what would you say?

4) What would you say if someone asked you why you are a Christian?

5) What practical things could you do to begin talking about Jesus to the people around you?

6) Are there specific questions you are worried about people asking? How could you prepare some answers?

PRAY

- Thank God for the gospel, which is his power to save us through faith
- Ask God to help you be confident and bold in talking about Jesus with people
- Pray for an opportunity this week to share your faith with someone

Going Further

Read John 4:1-24

- 1) How does Jesus naturally start a conversation with the woman at the well?
- 2) How does he see if she is spiritually hungry?
- 3) How does he deal with 'difficult questions'?
- 4) How much of the gospel does Jesus actually explain to her?
- 5) What principles could you take from this account to help naturally talk with people about Jesus?
