Jonah 1: Running from God

1) When were you last in a boat and why?
2) Read Jonah 1v1-16. What did you personally find most helpful from Rich's message on Sunday?
3) On Sunday Rich spoke about God being Gracious and Compassionate. a) Read Psalm 103v8-14 i) What do these verses tell us God is like?
ii) What do these verses tell us about how God feels towards us?
iii) How does God's Grace and Compassion help us when we sin?
iv) Action: Memorise part of this passage and think and pray into it during the week.
<ul> <li>b) Read Psalm 95v8-11 which is referring to the Israelites refusal to trust God in the desert after escaping Egypt (Exodus 17v1-7).</li> <li>i) What are the main ways we 'hear God's voice' today?</li> </ul>
ii) What do you think it means for you to 'harden your heart' after hearing God's voice?
iii) In what ways/ areas of life are you personally resisting God at the moment? Take some time to pray and ask God to show you.
iv) Why are you reluctant/afraid to obey God in these ways?
c) Read Romans 12v1-2 and Jeremiah 29v10-14 a) How do these passages fit with the way God is described in Psalm 103v8-14?

b) How could these verses help you to obey God in areas you find hard?

#### Read Acts 5v1-11

- a) What exactly did Ananias and Sapphira do wrong?
- b) Why do you think they did what they did?
- c) How is their sin and subsequent experiences similar to Jonah's? How is it different?
- d) Why do you think God killed them both?
- e) Do you think this was judgement or discipline? Why?
- f) In what ways are you acting like Ananais & Sapphira?
- g) How do you personally need to respond to this account?
