Jonah 4: Heart Surgery

1) What is the main thing you have learnt from the series on Jonah so far?
2) Read Jonah 4v1-11. Which point that Rich made on Sunday do you think will most affect your life over the next few weeks? How?
3) Read Matthew 9v35-38 a) i) How does Jesus feel towards the crowds who struggled in life and didn't know God personally?
What does he identify as their primary problem?
How does Jesus expect this need to be met?
ii) Rich challenged us on Sunday. 'Are you sitting comfortably under a vine while people perish?' What can you actually do to respond to this passage?
How similar/dissimilar is your attitude to Jesus?
b) Read Luke 15v4-7 Who does the lost sheep in the parable represent?
What is the priority of the sheep's owner?
How should this parable affect our thinking, our attitudes and our actions?
c) Read Ezekiel 33v11

What is God's attitude towards people who reject him and do wrong?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Romans 8v28-39

- a) What does it mean that 'all things God works for good' for true believers?
- b) What kind of things does the rest of the passage explicitly indicate?
- c) What does v29 tell us is God's purpose for us and for all the things he allows in our lives?
- d) What reasons does Paul give in v29-34 for us to have confidence in God working for good in our lives?
- e) What reasons does he give to support his claim in v39 that absolutely nothing will be able to separate us from his love?
- f) What do you think it means to be 'more than conquerors' when we face suffering (and even death)?
- g) How should this passage affect our thinking when life is tough?
- h) How does this passage expand your view of God and cause you to worship?
